Duff's, on a desolate corner a block from the East River, is set away from bustling Bedford Street, but it's not quite a throwback to the old neighborhood: We can't remember seeing any old Polish bars with Nosferatu masks, vintage nudie playing cards and an upright coffin. On a recent visit, a friendly, tattooed bartender suggested PBRs or \$2

shots of green, sticky-sweet "Jesus juice." Although the ingredients are a secret, it tasted a lot like Midori and Amaretto, Meanwhile, the metal-heavy jukebox, a holdover from the hearse-driving owner's previous venture, Bellevue of Hell's Kitchen, devotes as much space to indie classics like the Cramps as it does to softies like Peggy Lee. 28 North 3rd St at Kent Ave, Williamsburg
